New BC Guideline – published June 1st, 2018

Opioid Use Disorder – Diagnosis and Management in Primary Care

This new BC Guideline presents recommendations for diagnosis and management of opioid use disorder in primary care with a focus on induction and maintenance of buprenorphine/naloxone (Suboxone®) opioid agonist treatment for adults and youth ≥ 12 years. This is a summary version of the recently published *Guideline for the Clinical Management of Opioid Use Disorder* developed by the BC Centre on Substance Use and the Ministry of Health, available at bccsu.ca.
